
2. Regular Education

- This service will be offered until 2021.
- Villa Lilian headquarters will be sold: both Child Development Center and School.
- Will not be provided the service of Primary and Secondary levels

3. Social and Community Development

- Attention to early childhood will be carried out with strengthening in intervention in the family and community.
- Training for work and entrepreneurship for mothers head of the family.
- Promotion and accompaniment of community leaders who watch over early childhood accompaniment to families.

2. Care, support and development of 28,788 children. 100% response to the 14 contracts in the middle of the pandemic of Covid 19.






4. Services to early childhood in the different modalities which generated diverse strategics and learning that strengthens the foundation.

- A contribution of \$1,600,000,000 (million colombian pesos), was made in the care of early childhood system with the ICBF and the Government of Antioquia: Training of education agents through the alliance Eafit University–Fundacion Las Golondrinas, education Kits, Anthropometric equipment, Compulsory counterparts for contracting with the state.
- **1,209,096** home calls were made to advice about: Nutrition, Assessment of children development, education and psychology.





- Formation of financial and administrative committees from the Board of Directors, whcih guide the processes of the FLG.
- The Foundation carried out a pilot test of alternation of the ICBF in the El Porvenir Child Development Center in Rionegro, November 2020, becoming a participant of the Colombian State iniciative which measure the results.

Missionary Achievements



Missionary Achievements

1. Early childhood

- In Antioquia, 125,217 food packages were delivered; and 28,215 in Cordoba, to guarantee the feeding of the children.
- I,100 indigenous children and families from Antioquia and 87 in Cordoba were attended: Ethnic groups Embera, Zenu, Cuna, Tule and Embera Katvie, performing differential education accompaniment according to ethnicity issues.
- Assistance of 861 Pregnant and Lactating Mothers in Antioquia and 220 Cordoba.
- Assistance to more than a thousand Venezuelan migrant children.















Missionary Achievements

Early childhood

- Implementation and use of different technological strategies to reach the territories that are focus of our attention (whatsapp, text messages, email, synchronous meetings), making an economic contribution to achieve connectivity.
- 554 education agents qualified as the fundamental focus of the education model of FLG through a curricular design created by the same education agents who have experience the education model of the FLG.



Training of Education Agents



Early childhood

- The design of **1** diploma and **7** courses that were carried out jointly with the Eafit University alliance, of which 3 were entirely carried out by education agents of the foundation.
- Services and qualification of 838 Community Mothers to develop skills in comprehensive psychosocial, education and nutritional care.













Note:

- The nutritional assessment was not carried out in the Antioquia's Government contract due to the pandemic.
- The most critical cases of malnutrition were handled in the territories of Uraba, Frontino and Montelibano .

- 4 virtual meetings with the participation of 1,200 people on Facebook Live and Face to Face, on family dynamics and breastfeeding in Antioquia and Cordoba.
- Design of Education Model of FLG taking into account the entire process of characterization of the population: "Shields that protect me and protect you".







2. Regular Education

- Regular education was provided to 753 boys, girls, teenagers and young people at the Camino de Paz Basic School, Llanaditas and Villa Lilian campuses.
- 28 places were not enrolled in the school.
- 60 students graduated. There was no dropout.
- 23 graduates started technique and one in professional training.
- Psychosocial support at home with home visits.
- Design and implementation of information technologies in the school platform.
- Loan of computer equipment and internet recharges for students who did not have access and connectivity.
- 4,869 food packages were delivered to 415 students from Llanaditas and 126 from Villa Lilian campuses.

Elderly for Early Childhood

We provide food to 95 adults and vulnerable people in commune 8, in person, by delivering food and food packages at home. 2

Health emergency assistance

- Physical, emotional and housing stabilization of populations in a health emergency situation due to natural disasters in the Municipalities of Frontino, Dabeiba, Chigorodo and in the Barrio Pacifico of Commune 8.
- 14,834 food packages were delivered to vulnerable communities in communes 1, 8, 9 of the Municipality of Medellin, Uraba, Cordoba and Frontino, during the health emergency caused by Covid-19.

Indigenous Communities Assistance

During the pandemic of Covid 19, 65 family tambos were restored in the indigenous communities of Llanos de Rio Verde and Nusido in the municipality of Frontino.

Delivery of basic household goods and cleaning implements, which benefited 390 indigenous people.






Through a virtual and telephone counseling strategy, it was possible to influence the improvement of the physical and mental health conditions of children and their families.
